7:10 p.m. Request to Amend Order of Conditions 345-0450, 365 Benjamin St., Robert Van Dyke The applicant, Robert Van Dyke and Paul Grasewicz of GRAZ Engineering were present.

The requested amendment pertains to relocating the proposed house outside the 75′ no build setback from the wetlands pursuant to the requirements of the Town of Winchendon Wetlands Protection Bylaw. The plans show the house shaped like an L cannot be totally out of the 75′ no-build zone. A deed restriction is needed. It will restrict additional building and limit clearing on the lot. The distance of the boundaries need to be stated by using the two closes corners of the garage. Silt fencing will be installed along the 50′ line. Abutters of 353 Benjamin St. and 285 High St. were present with concerns of flooding. Agent Koonce and Engineer, Paul Grasewicz will do a site visit to verify the boundaries of the garage. There will be no drainage in the wetland area. A dry well will be installed for runoff. A 50′ no disturb set back is permanently marked in the house area. Kyle Bradley made a motion, 2<sup>na</sup> by Lionel Cloutier - **vote** unanimously approved to close the nearing.
