Business

Walked the site to review and assess three possible locations for the amphitheater

Adjourned to Town Hall: Purpose to move process forward and to set date and frame for January Community Workshop

Reviewed photo boards, site maps and sketches (barn)

Discussion

- 1. Amphitheater location and basic considerations/possibilities re design options/phases, seasonal vs permanent, etc.
 - Minimum includes: electric/lighting, pathway from handicap parking and parking
 - Concerns re design include: sound, lights, rain/weather, navigation to the site
 - Will be driven, determined by costs
 - Abacus will focus on sketches/options for amphitheater design
- 2. Need to contact National Grid asap re getting 3 phase power on the pole near the barn
 - Suresh will take this up with Keith
 - Important to emphasize with National Grid the community benefit/purpose
- 3. Parking options: along Ingleside Road or lots
 - Head-in along road to avoid having to drive around circle to change direction. Need to be wide enough to back out. Possibly stagger lots.
 - Or, parking lots set into woods would be more aesthetic and require less lighting. Consider location and how to nestle into woods and accommodate trails
 - Suresh will follow up with Keith and the Fire Chief re requirements for access road width, etc.
- 4. Community Building multipurpose
 - Options: house, barn, new building (garage isn't big enough; storage potential)

- Initial assessment: house doesn't merit reinvestment. Design new building or invest to save and repurpose the barn. If build new building, what do with barn?
- Reviewed possibilities with barn: use of floor space (2500 square foot/floor); elevator, stairways (one fire enclosed)
- Discussed need for electric, insulation; energy code, structural work
- Tracy will check on energy initiatives with National Grid
- Ability to generate revenues down the road
- 5. Site Survey what is needed in order to scope the costs for this phase of Park development
 - Received two bids in response to specs Abacus sent out. Very similar costs.
 - Options: start with a constrained survey, narrower in scope?
 - Want a proper survey for the amphitheater location and for access to the amphitheater.
 - o Will need survey to put out contract on parking
 - o Will need tree survey around amphitheater
 - o Question grades along road
 - Question: what can drone do?
 - Shauna and David will talk with surveyors re options & cost and make recommendation
- 6. Community Workshop January 30th
 - Update community and given them opportunity to respond to
 - o Amphitheater location & Preliminary findings re the design (?)
 - o Reuse of barn or new building; assessment of house (?)
 - o Parking (?)
 - Abacus will lead
 - o Kit of community activities
 - Slide show
 - Abacus/Julia will draft agenda to review with subcommittee in early-mid January either in person or via conference call
 - Have photos and more specific images of possibilities for this current phase and for future phases (i.e. outdoor classroom, picnic pavilion, barn, etc.
- 7. Discussion of OPM schedule update will be scheduled for after the January 30 community workshop.
 - Realistic: Bid in October 2020 (before Thanksgiving); Construction in March 2021
