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- Trick or Treating is from 5:30-7:30 and would be a conflict.
- See if we could get a special permit to run the event late from 8-11 to avoid interfering with trick or treating traffic.
- A suggestion was made to do the event on November 1st – “The Day of the Dead.”, but general consensus said it would be better to do it on Halloween.
 - Battle of the Bands: instead of paying people, have people come who would like to promote their bands to the community.
 - Concerts at GAR park; we were working to phase these out because of low attendance. Cailte Kelley was a great turn out for that type of concert with about 75 people in attendance, but the other band that came out didn’t have as well as a turn out. It would be better to have these kinds of events at Legion park due to being more centralized whereas GAR is more of a neighborhood park and not a place that gets a lot of drive by traffic
