- Ren Faire meetings will be taking place 2nd and 3rd Tuesdays 6pm via Zoom-Rajuli will be heading this up and be responsible for putting this information out to members.
- Rajuli will now be the large event coordinator. She will be in charge of coordinating Wyndonshire and Shakespeare at the Park.
- We will also be able to bring people in to help Shaina as needed.
- Shaina met with Murdock High School to reactivate volunteer signups for students who may be interested in participating in events. This will help fulfill their 10 mandatory community service hours.

 - Eventeny will cost \$2880 to renew. We will be canceling this because we are activating Clover, which will cost \$14.99 and can use QR codes to sell tickets and get all the info out to the town.
