- Trunk or Treat: Successful! Great turn out
- Fall Festival: Great turnout. Successful- Prezels did well for sales.
- Crafternoon
 - Wreath went great! Had a good turn out.
- Haunted Trails
 - Very Successful
 - At least double if not triple attendance from the year before
 - Donation totaled \$1335 in cash donations, great pretzel sales
 - It went too late. Next year we can do 5-9pm following the trunk or treat
 - Suggestions were made to have it extend to 2 nights.
 - We could have a soft opening on Friday and full blown trails on Saturday.
 - Get more scare jump volunteers-it would be difficult to have the same people commit to two days in a row.
 - It may be great to have it on the same day as the haunted community day to build out the event.
 - More volunteers to keep an eye on the trails would be great.
 - Have a map or more signage to direct people to where they should go.
- Renaissance Faire Update
 - Getting bids from 3 different companies to hire for this event.
 - We are hiring it out and the board will be responsible only for the structure of the event.
 - 80 spots for camping \$200 per tent
 - Need extra supervision for this
 - We are going to incorporate the trails and have vendors throughout so we can keep parking in the lot and soccer field and still have jousting which will go in the field closer to the amphitheater.
 - All merchandise will not be dated so that it is timeless and we can sell it in future years.
 - Need to choose a company in the next couple of weeks.
 - They will be responsible to get all of the acts etc
 - Also providing all of the advertising. A suggestion was made to also advertise air bnb's and camping spots in town.
 - This event has the potential to grow with the park.
 - We will also have overflow parking with bussing people in.
