a. **Superintendent's Update:** Dr. Goguen Introduce the new Interim Assistant Principal for Murdock High School. Discussed some scheduling changes to address open positions at Murdock Middle School. Discussed the Business Manager position search; reached out to agencies for quotes to help with the search. Budget meetings with the leadership teams will start 11/14. Discussed Rural School Aid, which increased from \$110,000 to \$278,000. End of year reporting is being done by an outside consultant, Tony Mertz. Audit is being moved to January 18th. Discussed the incident on Friday. PD scheduled for Nov 1st – drills and safety preparedness. Discussed a leadership curriculum instruction update – implementing learning walks, how to monitor student data and setting up stronger data systems. Dr. Goguen – Impressed with the community. Friday was a testament to teamwork.


K. Kast-McBride – Thank everybody for what was done to help make Friday less crazy that it had to be.
