

Report of the Town Manager September 27, 2018

1. Financial Updates-

a. There are no financial updates this week.

2. Personnel Updates-

- a. Richard (Pez) Pezzolesi has resigned as Wastewater Chief Operator .
- b. Maurice (Red) LeBlanc will be retireing from Public Works on December 21st.

3. Project Updates-

a. The final paperwork for the landfill solar array was completed and returned to the Town on Septmber 19th. The solar array should go on line during the week of September 24th.

4. Miscellaneous Updates –

a. Discussion on the Mylec TIF is not on the September 27th agenda due to a conflict in Mr. Laperierre's schedule. Mr. Laperierre was planning on attending the September 24th meeting and had made other plans for the 27th.

A complete streets application was submitted for sidewalk improvements. The projects contained in the grant application reestablish a pedestrian network along Grove Street, a key route that connects vital town resources, the Toy Town Elementary School, and the Winchendon Senior Center. The sidewalk replacement, installation and road narrowing will promote pedestrian travel where safety and a lack of accessibly will no longer be a barrier. Project extent is Grove Street Sidewalks from Central Street to School St on the South Side and Central Street to the Toy Town Elementary School on the north side.

Grove St Sidewalks South side project cost:\$165,612.16

Grove St Sidewalks North side project cost:\$180,393.17

Total Complete Streets Funding Request: \$346,005.33
