

# **Report of the Town Manager** June 12th, 2023

### 1. Financial Updates-

a. We are in the process of issuing supplemental tax bills through the Assessor's Office. This should help bring in additional revenue to close out FY23.

## 2. Personnel Updates-

a. No personnel changes at this time.

### 3. Project Updates-

- a. The Old Murdock restoration will officially be kicking off this week as the contractor begins to mobilize to the site.
- b. Lane painting on Central Street is complete.
- c. Beech Street cleanup will continue in the coming month, we are waiting on an official remediation plan from the LSP for contaminated soil removal.
- d. We have received our new Police Cruiser from last year's Capital Improvement Plan after waiting out an 8 month delay.
- e. The Fire Station working group continues to meet and will have an update for the BoS at an upcoming meeting.
- f. The Town Hall Cupola restoration is complete. The remaining budget will allow for the structure to be illuminated at light as planned.
- g. A meeting was held with an architect to beginning the process for the Town Hall East Elevation Restoration as approved at the recent annual town meeting.
- h. Winchendon has been selected as part of the Massachusetts Broadband Institute Digital Equity Planning Program! Great work by all involved, include Linda Daigle who spearheaded this effort as part of her special project assignment.

## 4. Miscellaneous Updates -
