1. Financial Updates-

- a. FY23 Year End is ongoing. Final year-end transfers will be brought before the board at your July 10th meeting.
- b. We officially hit our revenue targets for FY23 as projected.

2. Personnel Updates-

- a. Following an extensive review process that included a 3-week advertising period, Mr. Brian Croteau has been selected as the most qualified candidate for the newly created Director of DPW and Facilities role. He is the only candidate that had experience as a DPW head in Massachusetts, as well as the only candidate boasting a Massachusetts Certified Public Procurement Officer designation (MCPPO).

3. Project Updates-

- a. Staging will be installed on the Old Murdock early next week, weather permitting.
- b. Paving work has started in Pleasant Street with some repairs and resetting of castings to occur over the coming weeks.
- c. Soil remediation at 4 Summer Drive is ongoing.
