- The Conference was very beneficial and a great time
- The biggest take away is that we would significantly benefit from a Recreation Software.
 - Eventeny seems to meet all the needs we have and I spoke with about 10 different companies that do different types of software.
 - Cost is \$2,380 for the 1st year, which includes a \$500 discount.

Holiday Decorations

- Tiffany did speak with 2 vendors at the conference but hasn't been able to follow up with them yet.
- Andrew got information from a company regarding snowflake lights, wreaths, pole wraps, and banners
- · Can get 25% off in stock items
- Banners are the most cost effective option with ordering 50-74 of them at just \$56 each
 - Andrew needs to get a price for mounting hardware and if there is additional cost for customization as well as the price for shipping.
- If we order in January we can get a 33% discount on items.
- The consensus was to order 50 banners with mounts this year and purchase other decorations in January for next year to get a bigger and better discount.
- In the interim we will get some cheaper wreaths or pole decorations to try out on some poles to see what style we like best.
