## **TECHNOLOGY STATUS UPDATE**

**Covid 19 Grant:** This allowed us to update some older equipment. New Laptops, servers, etc...

**File Redirection:** Currently setting up all users machines to redirect files to the server so they will be backed up each night.

**Email server replacement:** The current server is running exchange 2010, new machine will be running Exchange 2019

**File server replacement:** This server will be standalone. Currently it is shared with the email server

**Remote server available:** users are now able to connect remotely. Laptops are available for anyone who needs to work remotely

**Grant awarded for file digitization:** We received a grant to digitize our paper files, so they can be accessed via the website. Currently developing files by street, and house number

**All desktops updated to windows 10:** Windows 7 has been retired, machines are now up to date

**New server for the Police dept:** Current server is about 10 years old. This is a much needed upgrade

**One of our newer servers will go to the FD, where there is no server:** One of the servers I am replacing at town hall will go to the FD as there is no server there at all for them to save files in a central location
