<u>Covid 19 Grant</u>: This allowed us to update some older equipment. New Laptops, servers, etc...

<u>File Redirection</u>: Currently setting up all users machines to redirect files to the server so they will be backed up each night.

<u>Email server replacement</u>: The current server is running exchange 2010, new machine will be running Exchange 2019

<u>File server replacement</u>: This server will be standalone. Currently it is shared with the email server

<u>Remote server available</u>: users are now able to connect remotely. Laptops are available for anyone who needs to work remotely
