- Discussion and vote regarding land currently under Chapter 61 protections at 185 Baldwinville Road.
 Said land is owned by Kevin Doyle who intends to sell this land as part of a two acre parcel containing a single family residence. The land consist of .818 acres pursuant to MGL c.61A (Forest Land) recorded with the Worcester Registry of Deeds at Book 48451, Page 86. The Town Manager has requested a recommendation to the Select Board on this parcel in advance of their discussion and vote scheduled for September 13, 2021.
- Possible vote following discussion of circumstances under which Conservation Agent might be permitted to allow tree removal or trimming. Discussion likely to include distance to wetland, number of trees involved and condition of trees.
