Chapter 131, Section 40, and the Town of Winchendon Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Winchendon Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on Thursday, January 14, 2021 at 6:05 pm to consider a request to Amend the existing Order of Conditions previously granted to Rodney Galton of Ecos Energy, LLC for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands on Spring Street, Assessor's Map 9 Parcels 97 & 98. The proposed amendment alters the proposed fencing locations related to construction of a 9 MW ground mounted solar array installation including work in wetland buffers and wetland crossings.
