Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 131, Section 40, and the Town of Winchendon Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Winchendon Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on Thursday, October 8, 2020 at 6:20 pm to consider the Notice of Intent filed by Scott Bullen for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 52 West Shore Drive, Assessor's Map 6, Lot 27. The proposed work will recreate a previously existing beach area – removal of grass and vegetation, replacement of sand and installation of a row of pavers to delineate lawn from beach area. The hearing will be held remotely via www.zoom.com or if it is safe to do so, in the 2nd Floor Auditorium of the Winchendon Town Hall, 109 Front Street.
