

To determine acceptance of Sections 3 to 7, inclusive of Chapter 44B of the General Laws, otherwise known as the Massachusetts Community Preservation Act, by approving a surcharge on real property for the purposes permitted by said Act, including acquisition, creation and preservation of open space, the acquisition, preservation, rehabilitation and restoration of historic resources, the acquisition, creation, preservation, rehabilitation and restoration of land for recreational use, the acquisition, creation, preservation and support of community housing, and the rehabilitation and restoration of such open space and community housing that is required or created as provided under said Act; and to determine the amount of such surcharge on real property as a percentage of the annual real estate tax levy against real property and the fiscal year in which such surcharge shall commence; to determine whether the town will accept any of the exemptions from such surcharge permitted under Section 3(e) of said Act or take any other action relative hereto.

Suggested Motion: Move to vote in support of Article 5, the Community Preservation Act, on the March 13, 2023 Special Town Meeting warrant.
