

This year's Triathlon has been selected as USA Triathlon's Regional Championship a prestigious honor which speaks to the great support we continue to receive from not only athletes but most importantly the community at large in Winchendon and North Central Mass. In addition, the event also hosted a safe and responsible offering at our post event Beer Tent with coordination from Wachusett Brewing for the past 4 years. Dept. of Conserv and Recreation approved this moving forward and we are applying for a one-day liquor license again with Winchendon in 2020 – please see addendum.

Our Volunteer Initiative Programs helped raise funds for various local groups, including the Murdock High School Student Council, Cross Country, Clark YMCA, and Gardner High School Cheer teams. 1st Swim Wave	8:00AM	8:22AM	9:22AM
Last Swim Wave	8:20AM	9:00AM	10:30AM

Unlike years past, with the new longer loop of the Bike Course, there will be a gap of **15-20 minutes** at front entrance between 9-9:22AM where Auto traffic will not be required to stop, as all the athletes will be out on the bike course.

By continuing with the Longer Looped Bike course we will alleviate 2 concerns:

1. Congestion & Backup: Motorists who have been patiently waiting to pass through the intersection will be free to pass for a 20-minute period.
2. Flow of Cyclists: Winchendon Police will know that cyclists leave the park turning left and return into the park turning left. There will be no athletes making another loop (as in years past).

Additional Information:

Safety Personnel at Front Entrance: Additional Officers are warranted at the front entrance of Lake Dennison to increase communication during the event, in addition to prevent cars parking on the state highway.

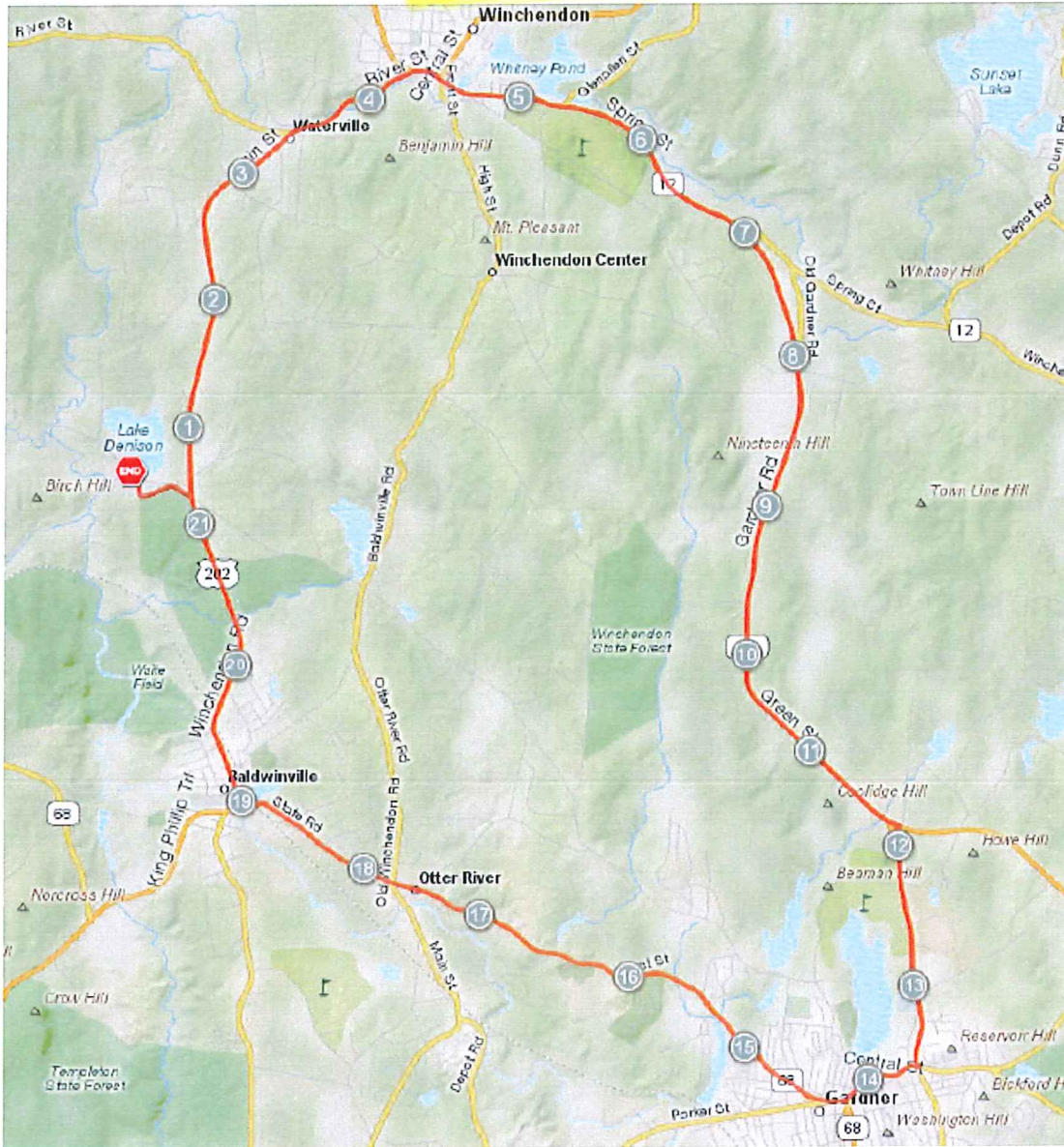

Bike Course



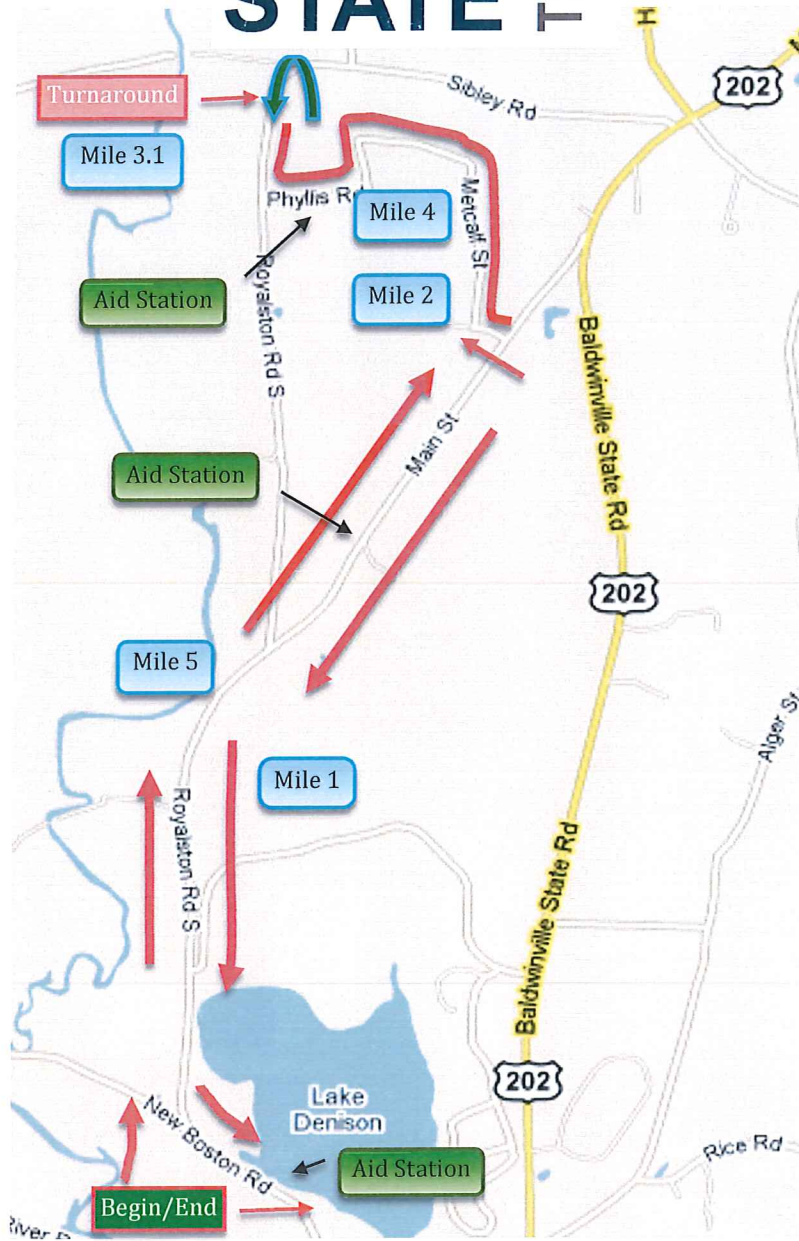

Description

The Run Course is 6.2 Miles of shady and relatively flat terrain, set on state park and local roads. It is an out and back style; runners will be on both sides of the road. A Turnaround point is located at 3.1 Miles. Aid Stations will be located at Mile 1.5 & Mile 2.7.
