

Bordering Land Subject to Flooding Narrative:

The proposed septic system upgrade project involves work within the 100 year flood plain, which is a bordering land subject to flooding (BLSF) per regulation 310CMR 10.57. The specific performance standards per 310 CMR 10.57(4)(a) have been met as follows:

- 1) Compensatory flood storage has been provided as shown on plan revision dated 1/12/22.
- 2) The proposed work will not restrict flow, not increase flood stages nor increase flow velocities.
- **3**) The area withing the BLSF is approximately 2,280 square feet and the impacted area is approximately 174 square feet, therefore (being less than 10%), it is presumed to not impair important wildlife habitat function.
