On July 22, 2021, Aaron Sabbs from Tighe & Bond visited the Winchendon Landfill (hereby referred to as the "Site") to monitor the grading and shaping activities of the Landfill Closure Project. The Site, which is located at 580 River Street, is the former Mabardy Landfill. It is owned and operated by W.L. French Corporation (Operator) as the Winchendon Landfill. As part of the Landfill Closure Project, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) has permitted the acceptance of up to 415,000 cubic yards of COMM 97-001 material as defined by MassDEP Policy. In accordance with Condition 13 of the Landfill Closure Agreement between the Town and the Operator, the Site was reviewed for compliance with the following documents:

- Corrective Action Design, prepared by Langdon Environmental, LLC, dated June 2019 and revised October 2019.
- Initial Operations Plan, by Langdon Environmental, LLC, dated January 2021, revised to include temporary rip rap settling area.

Landfill Operations

General landfill operations appeared to comply with best practices and the Corrective Action Design. W.L. French was not on site at the time of the site visit. Material placed since the previous site visit is in the general area of Section C-C of Sheet C-5 of the Corrective Action Design, within the limits designated for initial placement.

Small amounts of construction debris, including brick, rebar, concrete, and plastic sheeting, as well as general household waste were observed in the soils imported to the site. This waste was generally observed in the northern section of the site in the soils which appear to have been imported since the last site visit. These may be diminimus, and the recent rain may have exposed this material, but this should be monitored going forward to be sure that the material being imported complies with the COMM 97-001 requirements.

Stormwater and Erosion

Stormwater conveyances have been constructed per the Initial Operations Plan as revised to include a temporary rip rap settling area. This plan was submitted to MassDEP under a Major Permit Modification (BWP SQ 11). A swale, including check dams, has been constructed from the temporary stormwater basin to the temporary settling area. Overflow from the temporary stormwater basin runs to the settling area with a PVC culvert running beneath the access road. The swale from the northern section of the site to the temporary stormwater basin has not yet been constructed.

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Recent heavy rainfall has caused significant buildup of sediment within the stormwater management systems. The swale and settling area were laden with sediment and had standing water.

Erosion control was present along the northern, southern, and western edges of the site. The recent heavy rainfall has caused sediment to build up along the haybales and wood chip berms. In several locations, the sediment had overtopped the erosion controls.

In several areas, the sloped subgrade has experienced significant erosion. The northwest slope exhibited erosion in the area of the monitoring well. Continued erosion at this location could potentially impact the well's stability.

The access road at the southeastern toe of the slope has exhibited erosion and appears to have been stabilized with the addition of crushed stone.

The Operator maintains a water truck on site for dust control. Water from a basin in the adjacent southerly site has been periodically collected and sprayed on site to reduce dust.

Material Accepted

Tighe & Bond reviewed the attached Net Daily Summary Report received for the month of July, which details the total tonnage and number of loads of material received by the facility. As indicated in Table 1 below, a total of 16,002.93 tons of material was received in July, which results in 627,498.01 tons remaining of the total 788,500 tons permitted. Based on a utilization factor of 1.9 tons per cubic yard of soil, the total volume received in July was 8,422.59 cubic yards, which results in 330,262.11 cubic yards remaining.
