WHEREAS, Mr. Emmett Thomas Jeffers gave of his time and talents throughout his life - served in the U.S. Army, World War II Veteran, managed several local businesses, built a trucking company, owned and operated Toy Town Wood Waste Co., was a communicant of the Immaculate Heart of Mary Church, member of Eugene M. Connor Post 193 American Legion and the Winchendon Chamber of Commerce, former member of the Knights of Columbus and the Kiwanis Club, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Emmett Thomas Jeffers was a self-made man with a sense of humor and purpose who loved his family, his country and his hometown of Winchendon which he frequently referred to as **"THE BEST LITTLE TOWN IN THE WORLD – A UTOPIA,"** and

WHEREAS, Mr. Emmett Thomas Jeffers contributed to the economic growth of the town he loved, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Emmett Thomas Jeffers' daughter, Maureen, and her husband Alan Ehnstrom, with their pride have donated to the Town of Winchendon in loving memory of her father two parcels of land that consist of the triangle directly in front of "Clyde" the Toy Town Horse at the intersection of Front and School Streets and the small lot at the intersection of Front and River Street, and




