## Minutes of March 5, 2012 Meeting of the Toy Town Partnership

They were corrected to state that a Boy Scout has 'expressed interest in using the Converse Gardens for an Eagle project, and not the bike trail. They were subsequently accepted.

<u>Converse Gardens</u> - Peter is optimistic that the Eagle project will end up with over 100 hours of donated manhours. We have \$500 of donated gravel that will be spread, assuming that project moves forward. Elaine mentioned a meeting sponsored by the Millers River Watershed Council

**Toy Town Horse**- Joe reported that the cracks near the saddle were surface cracks that should be watched, but are not critical. Joe said he will arrange for work to be done to modify the railing and move the sign to the opposite side of the horse. We will continue to leave collection cans at the bank to support the horse's upkeep.

**Bicycle Trail** -The 75% review has been completed, with the exception of the landscaping section. We hope to proceed with purchase of the intended parcel very soon after the 75% is accepted. The paving of Butler Rd has been included as part of the 100% plan, with a spur provided to North Ashburnham Rd.

<u>Colonial Cooperative Account</u> - Elaine has contacted Roy Gilbert to address moving that money. We voted to direct those funds to the Garden project.
